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# Introduction

## General description of the institution

The Art College of Nantes-Métropole (ESBANM) is a college with a national and international reputation.

ESBANM has been a public cultural collaboration institution (E.P.C.C) since 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010, financed by Nantes-Métropole, the City of Nantes, and the Ministry for the Arts and Communication.

The college's main mission is higher education and research in the field of visual arts and art education for all. The college also puts on cultural activities based on the connection between works produced and the media.

In 2012/2013, 235 students will be studying for a career in contemporary art and visual creation. The college is spread over two sites: the Fénelon site in the city centre (5 rue Fénelon) which houses students from the 1<sup>st</sup> course cycle (L1, L2, L3), technical workshops and the library, and the Félix Thomas site (39 rue Félix Thomas – Tramway line 2: Saint Félix stop) for students from the 2<sup>nd</sup> course cycle (M1 and M2), and research workshops.

There are two national diplomas available to students: the D.N.A.P. (National Diploma in Visual Arts) awarded after three years, and the D.N.S.E.P. (National Postgraduate Diploma in Visual Arts) at Masters level awarded after five years and registered at level 1 of the national directory of professional certification.

## History

Created more than two centuries ago, the Nantes Art College is currently one of the oldest in France. Following considerable educational and technical changes carried out since the 1960s, ESBANM (whose current status dates from 1904) is widely recognised nowadays for its dynamism and innovative spirit. Several famous artists can be found among its former students, including Jean Metzinger, Jean Gorin, Jacques Vaché, Benjamin Péret, Claude Cahun, Jacques Villeglé, Philippe Cognée, Pierrick Sorin, Fabrice Hyber, Christelle Familiari, Laurent Moriceau, and Pony Pony Run Run, etc.

The aesthetic revolutions of the 20<sup>th</sup> century which include modern and abstract art, conceptual and minimalist

art, multimedia, contemporary art, have all had an important influence on teaching the visual arts. Since the 1960s, ESBANM has moved away from the academic model inherited from the 19<sup>th</sup> century which involved masters' workshops, prioritizing technical education, and compartmentalisation of genres. The new teaching methods prepare students to be innovators and creative designers of visual arts within the contemporary art field.

## Teaching

Students at the ESBANM start by learning about personal creativity along with the study of drawing, image/painting, volume and media.

The general knowledge teaching includes the following courses: art history and theory, network creation, networking and collaborating with people involved in the fields of art, and professional English language studies.

The career path students take is individually tailored. The course is built around students' individual artistic projects, intense general knowledge teaching, and the knowledge of artistic contexts. The goal is to emphasise everyone's distinctive skills, talents and individuality, and enable them to become creators open to the contemporary world.

Students may take classes in various media and contemporary screen media, sculpture and sound, drawing to painting and digital imaging. These forays into different forms of expression encourage students' versatility and their long term integration into the world of work within the art and visual art industries.

The DNSEP offers training as a designer within creative industries or as an independent artist. The cross-disciplinary skills acquired during training enable students to develop their skills in the following professions: art, visual arts teaching, the art industry, the graphic arts industry, cultural publicity, art management, art restoration, decoration, theatre direction, museum management, designer-director, multimedia, photography, art criticism, and gallery management.

## AEBAN: the art college students' association

purchase credit which can be used to  
purchase materials at preferential rates  
(see page 6).

## Workshops

ESBANM has technical workshops run by specialist technicians. Students carry out their art work there, in connection with the teaching team.

The *wood, metal and volume* workshops make up the "construction" area, devoted to sculpture and a variety of three-dimensional creations (classic modelling in various materials).

The *engraving, lithograph, offset, and screen printing* workshops are the areas for printing books and prints, and for printing on objects.

The *photography, sound* (electroacoustic studio), *video and computing* workshops combine new media with analogue (traditional) or digital (computer assisted) technology.

### **AEBAN: the art college students' association and the co-operative**

The art college students' association (AEBAN) runs a co-operative that offers students, in return for a fee, the chance to purchase credit which can be used\*:

- for printing in the lithography, photography, and digital workshops;
- for buying materials specific to some workshops;
- for producing editing projects, etc.

This credit comes in several denominations:  
- a "pistachio" card with a prepaid value of €15,  
- a "salmon" card with a prepaid value of €30.

\*this equates to a contribution towards the cost price.

This non-transferable card is valid throughout the time students are studying at ESBANM. It is not refundable even in the event studies at ESBANM are interrupted.

Since 2000, the college has been the beneficiary of a large donation from the Regional Council of the Pays de la Loire and the Ministry for Arts/D.R.A.C. of the Pays de la Loire. The college is an experimental institution with a high volume of contact time, and extensive digital equipment. Since 2005, the college's new Internet site has provided access to general information on education, international relations, and practical amateur art courses, as well as the college's current education and events programme. The [www.esba-nantes.fr](http://www.esba-nantes.fr) site is the main access point for passing on internal and external information. It also enables the archiving of data linked to the college's artistic and cultural activities, with a collection of photo, sound and video images, D.N.A.P. and D.N.S.E.P. diplomas, exhibitions, and art education courses, etc. It has over 10,000 visitors a month. A virtual tour of the college is now available to everyone.

Students are allocated an electronic mail box which allows them to receive practical information linked to college life, information on contemporary art news, requests for internship applications, course information, etc.,

and to communicate with all of the lecturers and administrative and technical staff.

Admission to the first year is via an entrance examination, held annually, and open to all French or overseas candidates who hold a baccalaureat or equivalent qualification. Candidates who have not passed the baccalaureat may be admitted at the discretion of the committee. Foreign candidates are asked to provide their certificates (baccalaureat or equivalent), translated into French. A good knowledge of French is desirable.

Requests for a registration form can be made on the [ESBANM](#) site. The application form costs **€38.00**.

#### **Registration rates at ESBANM** (Education fees)

**L1 students:** **€359.00** for the 2012/2013 university year (€333.00 + €26.00 corresponding to the medical examination which is compulsory in L1).

### Board of Governors

The establishment is administered by a board of governors and its president. It is run by the director, aided by a teaching and scientific committee, and the student body.

The board of governors is presided over by Chantal CUSIN-BERCHE, contemporary art specialist. She was director of the National Centre for the Visual Arts (CNAP) from 2003 to 2008, a public institution under the supervision of the Ministry of Art and Communication.

The board of governors comprises:

- 3 qualified individuals
- 2 representatives from the City of Nantes
- 9 representatives from Nantes Métropole
- 2 State representatives
- 4 elected staff representatives
- 2 elected student representatives

The board of governors considers all issues relating to the running of the establishment.

### The teaching, scientific committee and student body (CPSV)

The CPSV comprises:

- The Presiding Director
- 5 representatives from the teaching staff (elected for a period of 3 years, renewable)
- 1 staff representative from the workshops (elected for a period of 3 years, renewable)
- 1 staff representative from the library (elected for a period of 3 years, renewable)
- 3 student representatives (elected for a period of one year, renewable)
- The Regional Director of Cultural Affairs
- The Director General for Higher Education in Nantes Métropole
- The Director General for Culture in the City of Nantes
- 1 qualified individual from the art world

The teaching, scientific committee and student body (CPSVE) is an elected committee. It is consulted on all issues touching on the establishment's educational and international activity as well as that relating to the student body.

## Field work for ESBANM students

ESBANM strongly encourages all students to carry out field work during the course of their studies.

Apart from internships in France, all field work projects are submitted to the Teaching and Scientific Committee and the ESBANM Student Body.

ESBANM offers 3 field work opportunities:

1. a period of study at a foreign European college under the ERASMUS programme
2. an individual project in France or abroad, or a study period not included in the ERASMUS programme
3. an internship in France or abroad

### 1 - PERIOD OF STUDY AT A FOREIGN EUROPEAN ART COLLEGE UNDER THE ERASMUS PROGRAMME

Candidates eligible for this opportunity:

- priority is given to 1<sup>st</sup> year students: L2 (T3 and/or T4) and L3 (T5). An Erasmus secondment helps students develop an individual approach and learn techniques and gain expertise in areas other than those offered at ESBANM. It also enables improvements in language, cultural, and artistic skills, thanks to its time period, which can be for up to 2 terms.
- in special circumstances this opportunity may be extended to 2<sup>nd</sup> year students: M1 (T7 and/or T8) and/or M2 (T9) students may apply. For M1 students, field work may be used as an internship.

The period of study at the accommodating establishment must correspond to the schedule for year of study in which the student is enrolled at ESBANM. **Exception:** M1 students in L2 will be accepted at the Central St Martin's College of Art and Design in LONDON.

**Important:** A period of study may not, under any circumstances, be undertaken during the same period as other field work opportunities.

### Application

1. Students should register with Hubert Bernier as an Erasmus candidate at the presentation of field work opportunities meeting, which takes place in mid-January each year, at the start of the 2<sup>nd</sup> term. They should then prepare a file (see recommendations for putting together a digital portfolio) stating clearly the visual arts research subject and the mediums used, illustrating it with a choice of individual work with captions, together with reasons for wanting to take up the field work (its appropriateness for their research, specific technical apprenticeships as well as those within the cultural and artistic environment). They should choose 2 colleges from the 25 partner institutions which would meet expectations,
2. Make an appointment with Mrs Patricia Solini ([patricia.solini@esba-nantes.fr](mailto:patricia.solini@esba-nantes.fr)), coordinator of the ERASMUS programme, in order to check choices and complete the digital portfolio,
3. Provide a covering letter to one of the ESBANM visual arts lecturers,
4. Provide a curriculum vitae,

6. Send the complete file to Hubert Barnier, who will check all applications, at least one week before the CPSVE deadline. CPSVE dates for 2011/2012: 14/02/2012, 27/03/2012, 24/04/2012, 29/05/2012 and 26/06/2012.

### **Recommendations for putting together a digital portfolio for an Erasmus exchange project**

- **In pdf format (10 to 15 pages maximum) with the correct layout**

#### **1. Documents:**

- **Student statement (in French and English):**

*This is a general piece of writing on your visual art work explaining your research. It should be presented in headed paragraphs for greater understanding, in chronological or thematic order, and including references.*

- **Covering text (in French and English)**

*A piece of writing explaining your reasons with regard to your choice of colleges (technical apprenticeships, cultural and artistic environment, linguistic knowledge)*

- **Choose 2 colleges** in order to widen possibilities, because demand will be high
- **Letter of support from a lecturer** commenting on your work and the appropriateness of an exchange abroad.

#### **2. Images:**

- Include **examples of your best work** (sketches, drawings, paintings, photos etc.) **duly labelled** (name of the work and year of creation).
- If your choice of college is linked to a specific teaching programme, include **more work in this field** (a photo, painting, drawing, installation, theatre design).
- If possible, include **a project sample** demonstrating your method of designing and examining a project and the different ways of developing it, from the initial sketch to completion.

Students at the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> year applying for an exchange in the 2<sup>nd</sup> year should provide a substantial range of different types of work.

#### **Approval by the accommodating establishment**

- The field work project is systematically submitted to the chosen accommodating establishment for approval (together with the curriculum vitae, it should be translated into the language of the accommodating country, if possible, or at least into English).
- A study contract or Learning agreement for the Erasmus programme is co-signed by ESBANM, the accommodating establishment and the student. It specifies the courses that the student will follow abroad and the number of corresponding credits. ESBANM takes account of all credits obtained in the accommodating institution. In the event the student does not obtain all the credits, a programme to help make them make them up will be made available by ESBANM on their return.

#### **CAF**

If you are a student and you are paying rent, you could be entitled to housing benefit from the C.A.F. (Caisse d'Allocations Familiales - Family Allowance office). This rent assistance is calculated according to your means.

To take advantage of this assistance you need to obtain a form from the **Caisse d'Allocations Familiales** or the *Guichet Unique*. You will need to provide the following documents:

- a photocopy of your ID card or passport, and a photocopy of your residence permit,
- a tax return for the previous year,
- a bank statement,
- photocopies of your rent receipts.

### **If you are renting in private accommodation:**

You should fill in a rental agreement and make an inventory of fixtures with the owner. Look carefully at the length of the contract and above all the notice period for leaving (this is usually 3 months before the desired departure date).

You will also be asked for a guarantee deposit equal to one or two months' rent, reimbursable on your departure if no damage has occurred.

You will need to give the name of a reliable guarantor (someone who undertakes to pay if you fail to pay your rent). This person must be resident within the European Union. They will be asked to provide proof of identity and resources (i.e. their most recent pay slip and tax statement).

You will need to take out insurance cover against fire, water damage, and civil liability (ask for information about this at student insurance companies).

### **Note**

If you find your accommodation via a property agency, you will generally have to pay a month's rent in agency fees.

Some agencies also offer, for an inclusive sum (usually €150) access to a list of accommodation available. **This sum will not be reimbursed, even if you do not find accommodation through this agency.**

## Getting around in Nantes

### Airport

Nantes Atlantique airport (Tel/fax: +33 02 40 84 80 80 – Fax: +33 06 07 38 96 60) is located 10 km south west of Nantes. The airport shuttle bus (TAN air) will take you right into the town centre. The bus ticket is valid across the entire network for one hour, and may be purchased in the shuttle, in the TAN offices, or in automatic ticket machines.

### Station

The trains belong to the S.N.C.F. network. On short journeys, you can use the S.N.C.F. bus or the T.E.R. (Trains Express Régionaux). On long journeys, use the "trains corail" or the T.G.V. If you travel on the T.G.V., you must reserve in advance. The road and railway stations are located in the centre of Nantes. If you arrive by train, you should follow the signs "Accès Nord/Accès Sud" in order to reach the tramway or bus stops. From Nantes, the SNCF offers a fast service to Paris (2 hours), and Lyon (4 hours). Obviously, there are connections for all other cities in France. If you are under 25 years of age, you can purchase an under 25 card. This will enable you to benefit from a 25-50% reduction depending on the period in which you are travelling, for an unlimited number of journeys.
